

D1F10 - NOTES AND COMPUTED VARIABLES  
(Tobacco Questionnaire)

Any value greater than 10 for the variable D10LVHME (the number of persons that the participant lives with that smoke cigarettes) was verified by the clinical centers. These three participants were either in the service or in prison.

For the variable D10EXHME (number of hours of exposure to smoke at home), the data entry system will only accept values less than 100. Thus, there may be some underreporting of smoke exposure.

Computed Variable

D10SMOKE: reported smoking status; calculated using the following algorithm:

IF D10TOBAC=2 AND D10CIGS=1 THEN D10SMOKE=0;
IF D10TOBAC=2 AND D10CIGS=2 AND D09SMKNW=1 THEN D10SMOKE=1;
IF D10TOBAC=2 AND D10CIGS=2 AND D09SMKNW=2 THEN D10SMOKE=2;
```
